

### DIRECTIONS TO GRAZING ACRES

From Route 896 in New London turn West onto State Road (toward Airport). Go 1/4 mile and turn left onto Lewisville Road (Also called New London-Lewisville Road). Grazing Acres is the first farm on the left past Walnut Glen Road.

From Route 841 heading North, go left (actually almost straight ahead) onto Lewisville Rd. Cross new bridge and Grazing Acres driveways are the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> on the right.

**(New bridge is complete and detour is ended!!)**

### DIRECTIONS TO FOX MEADOW

From Route 82, turn West onto Route 926. Fox Meadow is on the right - turn at the Simperts Insurance sign. Farm is located behind the agency.

Going West on Route 926, go past Northbrook Road, and turn left at the Simperts Insurance agency sign. Fox Meadow is located behind the agency.

### DIRECTIONS TO KA EQUESTRIAN

From Route 41 turn North onto Derry Meeting Road.

From Route 796 go directly across Route 41 which becomes Derry Meeting Road.

KA Equestrian is 1/2 mile from Route 41 at the top of the second hill on the right.

## HALTER

Open to horses/ponies age 3 and under. Judged primarily on conformation, but manners to be considered.

### 200. Halter class 3 and Under

## LEADLINE

Open to riders of any age. Eligible for this division only horses or ponies permitted. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance. May ride English or Western.

1. Leadline - walk
2. Advanced leadline - may be asked to trot or demonstrate a jump position
3. Off leaders - leader may stay with rider

## MINI-MINI STIRRUP

Open to riders 8 and under. Open to horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. May ride English or Western.

4. Mini-Mini stirrup walk
5. Mini-Mini stirrup walk, trot/jog
6. Mini-Mini stirrup walk, trot/jog, back

## MINI STIRRUP

Open to riders ten and under. Open to horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. May ride English or Western.

7. Mini stirrup walk
8. Mini stirrup walk, trot/jog
9. Mini stirrup walk, trot/jog, back

## SHORT STIRRUP

Open to riders 12 and under. Open to horses/ponies ridden English or Western. Judged on hands, seat, leg, and control.

10. Short stirrup walk
11. Short stirrup walk, trot/jog
12. Short stirrup walk, trot/jog, canter/lope
13. Short stirrup X-rails - 12" fences

## OPEN EQUITATION

\*Judged on rider. Open to all ages over 13 and all seats.

14. Equitation walk, trot/jog
15. Equitation walk, trot/jog, back
16. Equitation walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

## OCTOBER SHOW ONLY

### 300 Funny costume class

Informal workmanlike attire for riders accepted in the following divisions. Must wear a hard hat and a boot with a heel. Horses to be in correct attire.

## WESTERN

Open to all ages. (Class 18 is not a high-point class.)

17. Western pleasure walk, jog
18. Western limit (not to have won 6 blues) walk, jog, lope
19. Western pleasure walk, jog, lope
20. Western equitation

## PLEASURE HORSE/PONY

Judged on manners and performance, open to all seats. Ten or more riders equal cash award.

21. Pleasure walk, trot/jog
22. Pleasure walk, trot/jog, canter/lope
23. Pleasure walk, trot/jog, canter/lope, back
24. Pleasure horse/pony pattern

## BEGINNER RIDER OVER FENCES

Open to horses and ponies. Open to riders of any age. Judged on rider. May trot fences.

25. Four fences - 12"
26. Six fences - 18"
27. Eight fences - 2'

## BABY GREEN

Horses/ponies in first year of showing. Open to all ages.

28. Walk, trot
29. Walk, trot, canter
30. 6 fences, 12"
31. Fences: Horse 2', Pony 2'

## LOW HUNTER

Open to horses that have never shown over 3' and ponies that have never shown over 2'6". Open to all ages. Ten or more riders equal cash award.

32. Over fences: Horse 2'6", Pony 2'
33. Over fences: Horse 2'6", Pony 2'
34. Hunter under saddle walk, trot
35. Under saddle, walk, trot, canter

## HUNTER HORSE/PONY

Judged on performance, manners, and way of going. Open to all ages. Ten or more riders equals cash award.

36. Over fences: Horse 3', Pony 2'6"
37. Over fences: Horse 3', Pony 2'6"
38. Under saddle walk, trot, canter

### Rules and Regulations

1. Owners of KA Equestrian Center, Grazing Acres, Fox Meadow Stables and/or the show committee will not be responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, horse/pony, or property of exhibitor/spectator on or off the show grounds.
2. Management reserves the right to divide, combine, cancel, or change the order of classes.
3. A child's riding age is the age as of December 1.
4. Limit classes are open to animals which have not won six blue ribbons in classes of that type.
5. It is recommended that persons in equitation classes wear proper attire. All riders are suggested to show in correct attire. Hard-hats with harness and boots with a heel must be worn by juniors when mounted.
6. Decisions of the judge/management are final.
7. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
8. Schooling allowed from 7 a.m. until start of the show and where permitted in the schedule.
9. No pets allowed on show grounds.
10. Fence heights are approximate.
11. Negative Coatings required, within 1 year.
12. Six ribbons awarded in all classes. Division championships and reserve awarded at each show.
13. Costume class held October show only.
14. Pre-entries accepted by phone.
15. Please use good sportsmanship and help keep the show ground clean.
16. Year-end high point awards presented at banquet.
17. Show uses a 2-minute gate.
