

DIRECTIONS TO KA EQUESTRIAN

From Route 41 turn North onto Derry Meeting Road. KA Equestrian is 1/2 mile from Route 41 at the top of the second hill on the right.

From Route 796 go directly across Route 41 (Route 796 becomes Derry Meeting Road.) KA Equestrian is 1/2 mile from Route 41 at the top of the second hill on the right.

DIRECTIONS TO GRAZING ACRES

From Route 896 in New London turn West onto State Road (toward Airport). Go 1/4 mile and turn left onto Lewisville Road (Also called New London-Lewisville Road). Grazing Acres is the first farm on the left past Walnut Glen Road.

From Route 841 heading North, go left (actually almost straight ahead) onto Lewisville Rd. Go right at stop sign and cross bridge. Driveways for Grazing Acres are the 2nd and 3rd on the right.

DIRECTIONS TO FOX MEADOW

From Route 82, turn East onto Route 926. Fox Meadow is on the right - turn at the Simperts Insurance sign. Farm is located behind the agency.

Going West on Route 926, go past Northbrook Road and turn left at the Simperts Insurance agency sign. Fox Meadow is located behind the agency.

DIRECTIONS TO SHADY HOME

From Route 472 turn West onto Frog Hollow Road. Farm is on the right at the intersection with Waterway Road.

WESTERN

Open to all ages. (Class 2 is not a high-point class.) Informal, workmanlike, attire for riders accepted. Tack to be correct.

1. Western pleasure walk, jog
2. Western limit (not to have won 6 blues) walk, jog, lope
3. Western pleasure walk, jog, lope
4. Western equitation

LEADLINE

Open to riders 6 and under. Eligible for this division only - horses or ponies permitted. Judged on hands, seat, and general appearance. May ride English or Western.

5. Leadline - Walk
6. Advanced Leadline - may be asked to trot or demonstrate a jump position
7. Off Leaders - Leader may stay with rider

BEGINNER RIDER

Open to riders 6 and up in first or second year of showing. Not eligible for Leadline. Judged on rider. May trot fences

8. Beginner over fences - 12"
9. Beginner walk
10. Beginner walk, trot
11. Beginner walk, trot, canter

MINI-MINI STIRRUP

Open to riders 8 and under. Open to horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, general appearance, and control of mount. May ride English or Western.

12. Mini-Mini stirrup walk
13. Mini-Mini stirrup walk, trot/jog
14. Mini-Mini Walk, trot/jog/dismount

MINI STIRRUP

Open to riders 10 and under on horses or ponies. Judged on hands, seat, appearance, and control. Ride English or Western.

15. Mini stirrup - walk
16. Mini stirrup - walk, trot/jog
17. Mini - walk, trot/jog, dismount
18. X-Rails

SHORT STIRRUP - B (BEGINNER)

Open to riders 12 and under who have not won a blue or red ribbon prior to the start of the season. Open to horses/ponies ridden English or Western. Judged on hands, seat, leg, and control.

19. Short stirrup walk
20. Short stirrup walk, trot/jog
21. Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope
22. Short stirrup - 12" fences

SHORT STIRRUP - A (ADVANCED)

Open to advanced riders 12 and under. Open to English or Western horses/ponies. Judged on hands, seat, leg, and control.

23. Short stirrup walk, trot/jog
24. Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope
25. Short stirrup - 18" fences

PLEASURE PONY

Judged on manners and performance, open to all seats. **More than ten riders equals cash award.**

26. Pleasure pony walk, trot/jog
27. Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope
28. Road Hack - may be asked to halt, back, extend/shorten gaits, dismount, etc.

JUNIOR HUNTER MEDALS

Open to riders age 18 and under.

29. Junior Hunter Medals 2'6" fences
30. Junior Hunter Medals 2' no irons

OPEN EQUITATION

Judged on rider. Open to all ages 13 and over and all seats.

31. Equitation walk, trot/jog
32. Equitation walk, trot/jog, back
33. Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope

PLEASURE HORSE

Judged on manners and performance, open to all seats. **More than ten riders equals cash award.**

34. Pleasure horse walk, trot/jog
35. Walk, trot/jog, canter/lope
36. Road Hack - may be asked to halt, back, extend/shorten gaits, dismount, etc.

BABY GREEN HUNTER

Horses/ponies in first or second showing year. Open to all ages.

More than ten riders for cash award.

37. Fences - X-Rails
38. Fences - 2'
39. Walk, trot
40. Walk, trot, canter

LOW HUNTER

Open to all ages. Jump classes may run back-to-back.

More than ten riders equals cash award.

41. Over fences: Horse 2'9", Pony 2'3"
42. Over fences: Horse 2'9", Pony 2'3"
43. Under saddle, walk, trot, canter

3. A child's riding age is the age as of Dec. 1, 2000.
4. Hard-hats with harness and boots with a heel must be worn by juniors when mounted.
5. Decisions of the judge/management are final.
6. No martingales permitted in under saddle classes.
7. Schooling allowed from 7 a.m. until start of the show and where permitted in the schedule.
8. **No pets allowed on show grounds.**
9. Fence heights are approximate
10. **Negative Coggins required, within 1 year.**
11. Pre-entries accepted by phone.
12. Please use good sportsmanship.
13. Show uses a 2-minute gate.
